Changing lives, one move at a time!

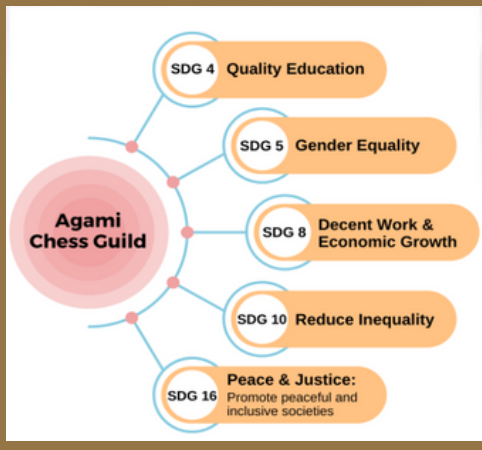
Agami's goal is to provide access to quality education to disadvantaged children in Bangladesh and give them a chance to be financially independent and become productive members of society. However, this education cannot be called wholesome unless we provide them with the necessary tools to exercise and enhance their cognitive, intellectual, and social capabilities. To respond to this need, Agami Chess Guild was born.

When taught at an early age, chess helps raise a child's Intelligence Quotient (IQ) and improves their visual memory, concentration, spatial reasoning, and attention span. All of these are very important if a child is to be given the best shot and if he/she is to have success in life.

ACG is in line with Agami's commitment to UN sustainable development goals.



Chess is easily accessible to all regardless of age, gender, cultural background, or physical abilities. In 2022, we organized Agami Interschool Chess Festival 2022 impacting 80 students. Dr. Shoeb Reaz Alam, additional DIG of Bangladesh Police was the chief guest at the event. The Grandmaster (2007) Reefat Bin Sattar, the first FIDE Woman International Master (1985) Rani Hamid, and International Master (2011) and National chess coach Abu Sufian Shakil were the distinguished guests in the tournament. This year we want more students to participate in the chess tournament and inspire them to enhance their enthusiasm for building a career in chess.

In 2021, 25 Agami Chess Guild students (14 Girls and 11 boys) took part in the Carnival Chess Festival organized by Dot Lines Group. Through this program, Agami created the opportunity for these children to play against Bangladesh chess Grandmaster Reefat Bin Sattar, Ziaur Rahman, and Enamul Hossain which is a dream come true for these children.

Agami also launched the Agami Chess Guild (ACG) 2021 Online Charity Tournament where at least 40 players from Bangladesh and North American schools participated and played against each other. The top 10 players from two age groups played a simul game against Bangladesh chess Grandmaster Reefat Bin Sattar. This was an exhibition tournament aimed to demonstrate that given the opportunity and access, disadvantaged children from Bangladesh slums can shine as bright as any privileged children from top schools in the most developed Nation.

Till 2023, Agami Chess Guild program developed 13 internationally rated players from two Agami schools and these students participated in various tournaments, such as Second Division Women's Chess League, National Youth Chess Tournament, Marks Active School Chess Tournament, National Women's Chess Championship, Begum Laila Alam 12th FIDE Rating Tournament, Elegant Chess and Manha's Castle Rating Tournament.

The approximate cost of executing the tournament is BDT 582,000/-.
