

From Adversity to Aspiration: The Inspiring Journey of Jahanara Liza

Jahanara Liza, a determined 15-year-old girl from Shariatpur, Bangladesh, grew up in a marginalized community with a family of seven, including her parents and five siblings. Their financial constraints, relying solely on her father (a driver) as the sole breadwinner, brought significant challenges, even for basic needs.

Despite these adversities, Liza's unwavering determination to pursue education and her dream of entrepreneurship shines through. In 2023, she is a diligent ninth-grader at Aalok Shikhlao, an Agami-sponsored school. Her educational path was riddled with social and economic obstacles, but her dedication to learning remained unshaken.



In 2021, Jahanara took a significant step toward realizing her entrepreneurial aspirations by enrolling in a six-month sewing skills development course organized by Aalok. The valuable skills she acquired during this training not only prepared her for a market-driven occupation but also attracted work orders from her community and neighboring residents.

Jahanara currently receives work orders from her community and neighboring residents for sewing and clothing alterations. Her monthly income, averaging around BDT 1000, has become a valuable means to cover her educational expenses and make a meaningful contribution to her family's finances.

Now, Liza has become a shining example for many underprivileged children in her community and beyond, who are struggling to continue their education, achieve self-reliance, and pursue their dreams of becoming entrepreneurs. Her remarkable growth and progress bring joy to her parents, community members, and teachers who take pride in her achievements.

She wholeheartedly believes that one day, she will be able to embark on a new entrepreneurial journey – establishing her own sewing shop, which is not very far from becoming a reality.

5th Annual Science Fair'23

On 27th October 2023 Agami Education Foundation (AEF) hosted its 5th annual science fair under the "Life Is Fun" (LIF) science program. 90 students from 5 schools participated in the fair. Students from grades three to five of Empyrean Hope School, Switch Tahmina Banu Bidyaniketon, PSD Pearabag School, Alok Shikkhaloy and Shohag Swapnadhara Pathshala submitted projects. The projects were on topics such as such as water quality and purification, waste management and recycling, renewable energy, etc.

The chief judges of this event were Dr Nova Ahmed, Dr. M R Kabir, and Jasmin Naher. The event began with all the students taking a short 15-minute quiz on some basic scientific concepts.

Improving English Teaching

Shining Stars: Agami's Triumphant Olympiad Champs!"

The Agami Education Foundation Bangladesh organized the '**Agami English, Math, and Science Olympiad 2023**' for underprivileged students in Agami-supported schools. The competition, aligned with international syllabi, highlighted exceptional talent and dedication among participants. In the Math category, students showcased remarkable problem-solving skills and mathematical prowess. Scientific innovation and insightful exploration marked the Science segment, while the English Olympiad revealed linguistic finesse and creativity. Champions emerged not only for their academic excellence but also for their perseverance and determination. Their achievements underscored Agami's effective nurturing of talent and provision of holistic development opportunities. The runners-up displayed commendable skills, making the competition intense and inspiring. This Olympiad signifies Agami's commitment to empowering disadvantaged students by following international standards, ensuring a comprehensive learning experience in English, Math, and Science.



Agami EdTech: 2023 milestones and future plans



Agami EdTech has effectively wrapped up the year 2023, navigating challenges within the education sector. Despite facing difficulties in adapting to the new curriculum for secondary-level education, progress was made in content development, particularly in Grade 6 Math. The team contributed to various projects and maintained momentum in ongoing initiatives.

A notable achievement was the completion of the Reinventing our Classroom (ROC) project, funded by the World Bank. Activities such as teachers' training, data collection, baseline and end-line surveys, and intensive monitoring led to positive changes in classroom environments. Plans are in place to extend the adoption of ROC activities to Agami schools in 2024.

Collaborating with UNICEF, Agami EdTech executed a year-long field project, culminating in mobile distribution for self-paced student learning and training sessions aligned with the new curriculum. The outcomes revealed a rise in classroom engagement, attendance rates, and students' satisfaction with technology integration.

The second and final year of the SCILLS grant showcased a hybrid intervention using technology and the Agami Learning platform across 8 schools. Over 130 tablets were distributed, enabling more than 370 students to enhance foundational math skills. Plans are in place to continue Tab classrooms as a self-funded project in Agami schools next year.



Renewing the partnership with BRAC for a second year marked another accomplishment, benefiting over 4700 primary and 450 secondary students in numeracy skill development. The Serve Foundation partnership contributed to improved scores in Bangla, English, and Math through various support measures.

The establishment of an E-learning center with a well-equipped computer lab, featuring platforms such as Khan Academy Bangla, Agami EdTech Platform, and others, sets the stage for comprehensive academic and non-academic courses for teachers and students in the upcoming year.

Looking ahead to 2024, Agami EdTech aims to diversify its content offerings, extending beyond Math and Grade 6. Science and Digital Technology will be incorporated into the content creation agenda for Grades 6 and 7. Additionally, the collaboration with Khan Academy hints at a nationwide scale-up, with ongoing efforts to create Bengali content for the Khan Academy platform.

As 2023 brought hope and new beginnings, the anticipation is for 2024 to be a year of effectiveness and continued progress in shaping the educational landscape through innovative technology solutions.

SCILLS grant: Influencing the learning advancement

The Strengthening Communities/Improving Lives and Livelihoods (SCILLS) grant was awarded jointly to Agami and Learning Equality by Internet Society Foundation with the aim of enabling individuals and communities to use the internet more knowledgeably and skillfully, ensuring economic inclusion and increasing educational opportunities. Agami EdTech's implementation has shown flourishing advancement among the students and teachers engaged in this program, and their exquisite response has provided motivation to continue the project for the upcoming years and expand its reach to further grades and schools.



The project encompassed 8 schools across Bangladesh, where 130 learner tablets (TAB) and 8 teacher tablets were distributed, and each school was equipped with a content server. Twenty math teachers from these schools were initially provided with training on blended learning teaching methodologies and the utilization of tablets in the classroom. Throughout the project, they received requisite support and additional training on the advanced application of the Kolibri Platform

Library Project finally wrapped up its activities of 2023 on a high note with the Library Festival hosted at its first ever outside Dhaka school Lyceum Child School in Netrokona.

This remarkable achievement stands testament to the invaluable support from the Agami Netrokona Chapter and our external partner, Volunteer for Bangladesh (VBD) Netrokona.



A dedicated team of 10 VBD volunteers managed the entire Library Project, seamlessly guiding the project from scoping to triumphant implementation. The Library Festival, held on December 27th, saw the enthusiastic participation of 40 students.

Special thanks go to Abdur Rahman Khan, Agami Netrokona Chapter Coordinator, for skillfully overseeing the Library Project's operation in Netrokona. His efforts played a pivotal role in establishing a successful technical partnership between ANC and the Library Project.

This successful operation will motivate us to form more bonds and collaborations over our common goal. Inspired by the impact of the Library Project in Netrokona, we look forward to another year of equal if not more significance and transformative accomplishments.
